<p style="text-align: center;">Neuberg 7 Manor Lane</p>	<p>Brick Wall- 6' high brick wall at rear of the property to match existing brick on the house.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Grossman 5 Dogwood Lane</p>	<p>Fence - 5' Estate black fence in front on the east and west side extending to existing side fences.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Castle Lake II LLC 5 Washington Avenue</p>	<p>Fence – 5' Almond matte finish fence along Broadway (70') and 4' almond matte finish fence/gate even with garage on front east side.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Feit 370 Kenridge Road</p>	<p>Fence – 6' stockade fence ONLY on rear of property to run to end of property Chain link fence NOT approved</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Marciana 320 Mulry Lane</p>	<p>Fence – 6' high White matte finish PVC fence along rear of property facing the Long Island Railroad replacing existing chain link fence</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Feldman 120 Harborview East</p>	<p>2nd floor addition- Triple gable farmhouse style-keeping natural stone in gray/brown – slate gray roof – painting brick white- white clapboard siding, gable in board and baton style both vertical and horizontal – metal skirt roof across front – rustic color garage door and shutters</p>
