Subject: Snow Removal Regulations

Dear Resident:

As we approach the snow season, it is important for all residents to be aware of the Village Ordinances concerning snow removal.


(A) Removal of snow and ice from sidewalks:

- (1) One and two family residential areas:** Sidewalks must be cleared within five (5) hours after the snow has stopped falling; or by 2 p.m. if the snow stopped after 7 p.m. the previous evening;
- (2) Business District and Apartment House areas:** Sidewalks must be cleared within two (2) hours after the snow has stopped falling; or by 11 a.m. if the snow stopped after 7 p.m. the previous evening.

If you will be away for any period of time during the snow season (December through March), please make arrangements for your sidewalks to be shoveled during your absence.

- (B) Do not shovel or direct your snowblower into the street, particularly after the block has been plowed.** The snow freezes into ice and creates a hazardous condition for vehicles and pedestrians.
- (C) Do not park on the street during a snowstorm or before the block has been cleared of snow.** The presence of even one vehicle on the street makes it difficult for the plow to properly clean the area.

As we approach the snow season, it is important for everyone to be aware of the Village Ordinances concerning snow removal.


(A) Removal of snow and ice from sidewalks:
